

Thank you for your e-mail from 13 October, in which you inquired about the possibility of obtaining organic certification for hydroponic systems.

Article 4 of Commission Regulation (EC) No 889/2008<sup>1</sup> states that hydroponic production, as defined in Article 2(g) of Commission Regulation (EC) No 889/2008 as "a method of growing plants with their roots in a mineral nutrient solution only or in an inert medium, such as perlite, gravel or mineral wool to which a nutrient solution is added", is **prohibited** in organic plant production. This is related to the principles of organic agriculture, which in accordance with Article 5(a) of Council Regulation (EC) No 834/2007<sup>2</sup> is based on the nourishing of plants primarily through **the soil ecosystem**.
