Thank you for your e-mail¹ of 26 July 2021 on the possibility to market sea salt with a term referring to organic production from 1 January 2022 in the absence of specific rules on organic salt.

As explained in our attached reply² to your similar question in your e-mail³ of 17 February 2020, Regulation (EU) $2018/848^4$ will apply from 1 January 2022 to salt labelled with a term referring to organic production and in particular the relevant objectives, principles and production rules laid down in Articles 4 to 10 and 16, as well as the labelling rules in Articles 30 to 33. Consequently, certificates for organic salt production may be provided for an operator or a group of operators complying with this Regulation.

Article 60 of Regulation (EU) 2018/848 on 'transitional measures for stocks of organic products produced in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 834/2007' does not apply to salt as salt was not in the scope of Regulation (EC) No 834/2007⁵.
